

MONTHLY SUMMARY ON IMPORTANT EVENTS FOR CIRCULATION AMONG THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS, SECRETARIES OF VARIOUS MINISTRIES/DEPARTMENTS ETC., IN RESPECT OF MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT FOR THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER, 2011

Monthly summary of important policy decisions/events pertaining to the Ministry of Urban Development for the month of September, 2011 is given below:-

1. Important policy related issues

- (i) This Ministry has issued the sanction order for Delhi MRTS Phase-III Project on 26.9.2011. An amount of Rs. 345.36 crore has also been released so far in financial year 2011-12. for Delhi Metro Phase-III Project.
- (ii) An amount of Rs. 100 crore has been released as grant in 2011-12 for Extension of Delhi Metro to YMCA Chowk, Faridabad.
- (iii) Sanction Order for Extension of Delhi Metro to Vaishali (Ghaziabad) has been issued on 5.9.2011.
- (iv) This Ministry has issued the sanction order for Project of High Speed Airport Metro Express Link from New Delhi Railway Station to IGI Airport – increased cost due to change of alignment, on 13.9.2011. An amount of Rs. 182.55 crore as equity has been released for this project so far in year 2011-12.
- (v) A meeting on flooding of Delhi Airport T-3 was held on 22.09.2011 under the Chairmanship of Secretary (UD). After detailed discussions, following decisions were taken:-
 - (a) DIAL will complete all the measures identified for implementation by them in a time bound manner under advice to this Ministry.
 - (b) Besides the macro level drainage plan improvement, area drainage plan and implementation action plan shall be prepared and submitted to MoUD within next 10 days after joint inspection by DIAL, DAMPEL and DMRC, so as to prevent any flooding in future of the T-3 Metro Station area.
 - (c) MOUD will take up with NHAI for rerouting the drain of NH8 near Radission so as to fall in PWD drain rather than the water flowing to T-3. DIAL will submit a draft with proposed drawing.
 - (d) DJB will take up the matter of Kapashera STP with Chief Secretary, GNCTC to resolve the matter. In case it is not resolved at Chief Secretary level, then Delhi Government and DJB should bring this issue for solution before Secretary, MoUD, GOI. In any case this matter has to be sorted out between airport and DJB so that DJB could go ahead with completion and commissioning of STP and the sewerage

which is getting discharged into the airport area can be diverted to DJB sewerage system once the STP at Kapashera is commissioned.

- (vi) 1st National Consultation Workshop to discuss the draft parameters for National Sustainable Habitat Mission (NSHM) for Urban Transport was held on 21st September, 2011 in India Habitat Centre, New Delhi under the chairmanship of MoS (UD).
- (vii) **Highlights of action under Urban Infrastructure and Governance (UIG) Component of Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM)**

Highlights of Progress made in respect of review of decision pertaining to privatization of Government of India Text Book Presses located at Bhubaneswar, Chandigarh and Mysore

On 1.2.2006, the Cabinet had approved privatization of Govt. of India Text Book Presses at Bhubaneswar, Chandigarh and Mysore alongwith reasonable operational land with the condition that the employees will continue in service till completion of their balance service period. However, In view of the recommendations of Parliamentary Standing Committee contained in 22nd report presented to Lok Sabha on 14.5.2007, it had been decided with the approval of UDM that matter regarding review of decision pertaining to privatization of Government of India Text Book Presses located at Bhubaneswar, Chandigarh and Mysore would be taken up with the Cabinet. The Note for Cabinet duly approved by UDM was sent to Cabinet Secretariat on 20.4.2010. Cabinet Secretariat informed that the Prime Minister's Office has advised the Cabinet Secretary to try to resolve the differences between the Ministry of Urban Development and Deptt. of Expenditure to the extent possible before bringing the matter to the Cabinet. The Ministry of Urban Development was accordingly asked to finalize a Note for the Committee of Secretaries. Thereafter this Ministry took up the matter with the Ministry of Finance, Deptt. of Expenditure who suggested to set up a Group of officers (i) to consider alternate use of land with Government of India Text Book Press, Bhubaneswar, Chandigarh and Mysore and (ii) to suggest ways/manner in which the staff of Government of India Text Book Press can be redeployed.

Group of officers considered the matter in the meeting held on 18.8.2010 and sent its report on 18.8.2010. The matter is under examination. A revised Cabinet Note is proposed to be circulated.
