G.S.R. 183.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Central Public Health and Environmental Engineering Organisation (Group 'C' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1986, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Draftsman Grade-II and Ferro-Printer in the Central Public Health and Environmental Engineering Organisation of the Ministry of Urban Development, namely:—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Urban Development, Central Public Health and Environmental Engineering Organisation, Draftsman Grade-II and Ferro-Printer, Group 'C' Posts Recruitment Rules, 1999.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application.—These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.—The number of said post, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in column 2 to 4 of the said Schedule.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit and qualifications, etc.—Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post, shall be as specified in column 5 to 14 of the aforesaid Schedule.

5. Disqualification.—No person,—

- who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall effect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

The qualification regarding experience is relaxable at the discretion of the Central Government for reasons to be recorded in writing in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes or the Scheduled Tribes, if at any stage of Selection Central Government is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.

Note 2. The crucial date for determining the age limit in the case of candidates from Employment Exchanges shall be the last date upto which the Employment Exchanges are asked to nominate candidates.

G.S.R.....In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Ministry of Urban Development, Central Public Health and Environmental Engineering Organisation, Draftsman Grade - II and Ferro-Printer, Group 'C' Posts Recruitment Rules, 1999 except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such amendment, namely :-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Urban Development, Central Public Health and Environmental Engineering Organisation, Draftsman Grade-II and Ferro-Printer, Group 'C' Posts Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2001.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Ministry of Urban Development, Public Health and Environmental Engineering Organisation, Draftsman Grade-II and Ferro-Printer, Group 'C' Posts Recruitment Rules, 1999, -

- (i) for the words "Ministry of Urban Development" wherever they occur, the words "Ministry of Urban Development and Poverty Alleviation" shall be substituted;
- (ii) in the Schedule, against the post of Ferro-Printer, in column 4, for the entry, the following entry shall be substituted, namely :-
"Rs. 3200-85-4900".
