G.S.R. 222. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the constitution and in supersession of the Ministry of Works and Housing Senior Analyst (Works Study), Junior Analyst (Work Study) and Research Assistant (Work Study) Recruitment Rules, 1981 published in the Gazette of India Part II, Section 3, Sub-Section(i) dt. the 19th September, 1981, insofar as they relate to the post of Research Assistant (Work Study) except as respect things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Research Assistant (Work Study) in the Ministry of Urban Development and Poverty Alleviation, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement:- (i) These rules may be called the Ministry of Urban Development and Poverty Alleviation Research Assistant (Work Study) Recruitment Rules, 2001.

(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts; classification and scale of pay. The number of the said posts, its classification and scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed hereto.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and qualifications etc. The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in column 5 to 14 of the aforesaid Schedule.

4. Disqualifications. No person,

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax. Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations/relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.
